## WACHUSETT BREWERY - PARKING PERMIT EXTENSION

The Board of Selectmen and the DPW Commission convened a joint meeting to discuss the extension of the Wachusett Brewery Parking permit.

After much discussion the Boards agreed to a 30 license extension under the following conditions:

- Meet with the DPW Commission and comply with conditions set forward regarding the wastewater coming from the Brewery
- Continued communication with the Police and Fire Chiefs regarding safety, road crossing, lighting, etc.
- Begin crosswalk and curb cut permitting with MassDOT
- Install a snow fence to insure no one parks on the inline sewer system area

H. Billings made a motion to extend the Brewery parking license agreement for 30 days, through July 22, 2019 according to the provisions above. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
