Complaint from Traditional Concepts, Inc.

Response from Mike Ferris to the invitation to the meeting for discussion

MINUTES

The Minutes of May 11, 2023 were unanimously approved.

Eagle Scout Project:

Eagle Scout, Ben Paradis, would like to attend to trail maintenance and install 95 - eight foot long bridges in the wetland area behind Westminster Elementary school as his project. Matt Marro volunteered to take responsibility for the cost of the legal notice as a donation to the project. Mr. Paradis will submit an RFD for the next meeting.

RFD/Continuation 183 Worcester Road Brown

The public meeting requested by Michael Brown for the addition of a second driveway in a buffer zone at 183 Worcester Road was not opened. Mr. Brown has not followed through with a plan or contacted Matt Marro for information for flagging the wetland. The Commission unanimously voted to continue the public meeting to give Mr. Brown another opportunity to do so.

NOI 83 West Princeton Road Vanderhoof & Rielly

The public hearing was not opened for 83 West Princeton Road requested by Sarah Vanderhoof and Alek Rielly for the construction of a new single family house with an associated septic, and well. Chris Mossman requested a continuation. The Commission unanimously voted to continue the public hearing.

COMPLAINT 32 WHITE PINE DRIVE:

Dan Bartkus abstained and Tim Sheehan took over for the Chairman.

A Complaint was received from Traditional Concepts, Inc. alleging that Michael Ferris used a skid steer front end loader and disturbed materials from the property at 32 White Pine Drive designated as a PFAS zone. Mr. Ferris was not present but had been asked to attend the meeting. Matt Marro noted that the disturbed materials were close to the buffer zone and a rain event may cause it to erode directly into the wetland, however, the Commission does not have jurisdiction at this time. It would become an issue if a rain event caused it to run into the wetland.

The meeting was adjourned with all in favor at 7:30 pm.
