## WESTMINSTER CULTURAL COUNCIL SEEKS FUNDING PROPOSALS

The Westminster Cultural Council seeks funding proposals for community-oriented arts, humanities, and science programs. Funds can be used for a variety of projects and activities in Westminster, including exhibits, festivals, short-term artist residencies, workshops, lectures or performances.

This year the Council will distribute approximately \$8,700. in grants. Previously funded projects include music events at the Community Senior Center; cultural programs in town schools; entertainment at the Farmers' Market; and various programs at the Forbush Memorial Library.

The Westminster Cultural Council is part of a network of 329 Local Cultural Councils serving Massachusetts. The WCC is funded by a grant from the Massachusetts Cultural Council as well as an allocation from the town.

## **Westminster Cultural Council Guidelines**

- 1. The applicant's program must benefit the citizens of Westminster.
- 2. The applicant, if not a Westminster resident, must submit a letter of support from the venue.
- 3. Each applicant must apply online at <a href="https://massculturalcouncil.smartsimple.com/">https://massculturalcouncil.smartsimple.com/</a>
- If the grant application is for an event that services people from Westminster and other communities, those other communities' Cultural Councils should also be solicited for funds.
- 5. Programs at the middle and high school should be funded by both towns' cultural councils. We will accept applications for cultural field trips for children pre-K through 12<sup>th</sup> grade by subsidizing the cost of ticket price and/or transportation.
- 6. The goal of the Westminster Cultural Council is to fund diverse programs for a variety of audiences/participants.
- 7. We encourage the applicant to seek and include on the application matching funds.
- 8. The window of eligibility for grant reimbursement/acceptance will be the calendar year following the grant deadline of October 17th. Projects must be completed between January 1 and December 31st. Applicants complete their applications online and submit them directly through the online system at <a href="http://mcc.smartsimple.com">http://mcc.smartsimple.com</a> by Tuesday, October 17, 2023.
