M. Ferris made a motion to extend the site plans 6 months. I. Grisos seconded. All in favor, motion carried (3-0-0).

Public Hearings:

5 East Main St -

The Special Permit, Site Plan Approval, & Storm water applications submitted by Eric Callahan of 8 East Gardner Rd, Westminster, MA 01473 for property located at 5 East Main St, Westminster, MA 01473, owned by the same, for a multi-use building. The subject parcel of land is located on Map 111, Parcel 23 and in the Commercial I (CI) zoning district.

- R. Forgues read the notice into the minutes.
- M. Ferris made a motion to open the public hearing. I. Grigos seconded. All in favor, motion carried (3-0-0).
- B. Marchetti presented and explained the project. The following are the main points of the project:

- One access point per MassDOT.
- The lot was walked with the Conservation Commission and the Town Planner in 2019.
- The building footprint is 4500 square feet.
- 4000 square feet of restaurant space.
- 2 1250 square feet of retail space.
- 2500 square feet of office space.
- 52 parking spaces.
- Tetra-Tech's comments have been responded to.
- Sewer stub is existing.
- Traffic study completed.
- Parking lot is One Way with parking in the front.
- · Outdoor seating for the restaurant.
- M. Ferris asked about lighting. B. Marchetti stated they are mainly pole mopunted lights with a few mounted on the building.
- M. Ferris asked about the regulation regarding restricting parking in the front. B. Marchetti stated the regulation reads if it were unavoidable, the Planning Board could waive the requirement.
- M. Ferris asked if the applicant could get relief from the ZBA for the front setback and locate the parking in the back, T. Murphy said it is possible to go to the ZBA.
- I. Grisos indicated an email was received concerning the siteline from the co-op area and the implementation of a visual barrier.
- T. Murphy asked about the easement plan. B. Marchetti explained there will be an easement plan to access the utilities, the process has been started with MassDOT.
- T. Murphy asked about the material for the walkway. B. Marchetti stated it is a modular material.
- J. Snyder suggested possible having the exterior maintain a colonial look. I. Grisos suggested a nicer looking roof rather that architectural shingles.
