Multi-family, commercial, industrial And non-residential new construction: Alterations/ renovations and accessory buildings	\$25.00 + construction value x .008 (\$50.00 minimum)
Municipal	Same as non-residential fees above or Fee may be waived by Bd. of Selectmen

PLUMBING AND/OR GAS FEES-Effective 07-01-2013 (PP & GP are TWO separate permits and fees)

2. Commercial & Residential Replacements

Total fees for all permits and inspections may be determined by the Plumbing and Gas Inspector according to the above schedule and/or not to exceed 10% of the building permit fee for the construction and/or 2% of the value of the plumbing and /or gas work.

NOTE: In addition to the permit fee, a penalty of double the fee will be charged if work is begun before a permit is issued and/or in violation of the provisions of 248 CMR, Section 2.04 (3).

AS PER 248 CMR. SECTION 2.04(3)(B): THE REPAIR OF LEAKS IN A FAUCET, VALVE, OR OTHER WORKING PART OF A PLUMBING FIXTURE, AND THE CLEARANCE OF A STOPPAGE: BUT NOT INCLUDING THE ALTERATION, REPLACEMENT OR RELOCATION OF ANY FAUCET, VALVE, OR OTHER WORKING PART OF A PLUMBING FIXTURE OR DEVICE, WATER SUPPLY, SEWER, DRAINAGE, LEADER SOIL, WASTE, VENT OR SIMILAR PIPING OR WORK AFFECTING PUBLIC HEALTH SHALL BE DEEMED A MINOR REPAIR FOR WHICH NO PERMIT SHALL BE REQUIRED

COMMERCIAL-BUSINESS-INDUSTRIAL

2. NON-RESIDENTIAL (COMMERCIAL-BUSINESS-INDUSTRIAL)

- a. New Construction/Addition (MINIMUM COST) \$100.00
- b. 1% of the electrical construction including materials or the minimum fee, whichever is greater. Proof of the estimate may be required with the application. Subject to change with the scope and final cost of the work
- c. Repair/alteration ~Subject to the same terms listed above in part b
- d. Municipal work~ Subject to the same terms listed above in part b

Fees may be waived by the Board of Selectmen

3. OTHER FEES

- a. Commercial meter \$ 75.00
- b. Additional meter/temporary service \$ 50.00
- c. Phone/Data work~ subject to the same terms listed above in part b
- d. Maintenance Permit \$150.00
- e. Solar Commercial fee is 1% of the total electrical cost, including the electrical material cost
- f. Other work not listed \$ 50.00

4. CONDITIONS OF ELECTRICAL PERMITS

***Permits expire one year from the date of issuance, or with change of contractor.**

An extension may be granted for good cause, if requested in writing and approved by the Inspector of Wires.

*Permit fees doubled upon failure to apply for a permit and pay the appropriate fees as required by MGL 143. Section 3

***Permit fees may be waived ONLY by the Board of Selectmen in writing.**

*Re-inspection fee \$50.00 for violations and work not completed per inspection
