- COUNCILLOR FOR SEVENTH DISTRICT
- SENATOR IN GENERAL COURT.....FOR WORCESTER & MIDDLESEX DISTRICT
- REPRESENTATIVE IN GENERAL COURT (PREC 1).....SECOND WORCESTER DISTRICT
- REPRESENTATIVE IN GENERAL COURT (PREC 2).....FIRST WORCESTER DISTRICT
- SHERIFF WORCESTER COUNTY
