ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of replacing a Police Cruiser that was totaled in an accident; the money so appropriated to be transferred from the account, "Receipts Reserved for Appropriation, Insurance Reimbursement in Excess of \$20,000," or other available funds, or act in relation thereto.



To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of repairing the Fire Department 2005 KME Ladder/Tower truck, which was damaged in a fire; the money so appropriated to be transferred from the account, "Receipts Reserved for Appropriation, Insurance Reimbursement in Excess of \$20,000," or other available funds, or act in relation thereto.
