The proposed septic tank and pump chamber are designed 95 ft. off bordering vegetated wetland and 75 ft. off Wyman Pond

Title V Request: 310 CMR, 15.212(1)

The vertical separation distance between the bottom of the Presby Envir-Septic Leaching System above the high ground-water elevation from 5ft. to 4ft. and reduction of the system location setback from private well from 100 ft. to 64 ft.

15.405(1)(b) The maximum allowable depth of system components required by 310 CMR 15.221 (7), from 36 inches to 72 inches below finish grade, provided that adequate venting and adequate access are provided and H-20 loading is provided for all components.

15.405(1) (g) Reduction of system location setback from private water supply well from 100 ft. to 64 ft.

15.405 (1) (j) Reduction of the requirement of a 12 inch separation between the inlet and outlet tees of the septic tank & pump chamber and the high groundwater, provided that all boots or pipe
