Emergency Certification

Bob Maki issued an Emergency Certification for the Greenwood Pond Dam to Gregg Linnus. The dam is located off of Shady Avenue and has been deemed a significant hazard by DCR. The work allowed under the Emergency Certification includes cutting trees on and below the berm and removal of debris blocking the spillways. Any future work needed to bring the dam into compliance will require a Notice of Intent.

Enforcement Order

Bob Maki issued an Enforcement Order to Claudia Lane of 70 Lanes Road for grading within the 100 foot buffer zone to a pond thereby destroying wetland vegetation. Ms. Lane was instructed to file a Notice of Intent before December 15, 2015

NOI 20 Edgewood Avenue Extension Gingras

7:12 p.m. The public hearing was opened for the Notice of Intent requested by David and Mary Jane Gingras for the construction of a 1,340 sq. ft. addition to an existing single family home and to stabilize the shoreline of Wyman Pond adjacent to the house. Proof of abutter notification was submitted. Chris Mossman gave the overview of the project and prosed using silt fence. Stabilization of the shoreline will take place when the water level has been drawn down to limit impact. The ZBA is reviewing this project. After review, the plan was unanimously approved with conditions upon a motion by Gary Smith, and second by John Regan. The public hearing was closed at 7:18 p.m.

RFD 43 Spruce Road Iannacone

7:18 p.m. The public meeting for the Request filed by Alfred and Rebecca Iannacone for the installation of a new septic system to serve an existing house at 43 Spruce Road was opened. Chris Mossman gave the overview of the project. Hay bales will be on-site in case of rain. After review, the plan was unanimously approved with conditions upon a motion by Gary Smith and second by Carrie Monty. The public meeting closed at 7:23 p.m.

RFD 5 Shore Avenue Aghjayan

7:23 p.m. The public meeting was opened for the Request filed by George Aghjayan for the removal of a hedge and replacing it with vinyl fencing at 5 Shore Avenue. The Commission reviewed the plan and suggested that hay be used to control erosion. Gary Smith made a motion to approve the plan with conditions. It was seconded by John Regan and was unanimously approved. The public meeting was closed at 7:30 p.m.
