

To view the entrée of the day, please refer to the Newsletter's "Activities" page, on the respective meal day (Monday, Wednesday, or Friday). To reserve your seat, please call the Senior Center. Reservations are required with a minimum 24-hour advance notice. Enjoy a hearty meal and great company, while someone else does the cooking and cleaning!
- ► The Westminster Senior Center utilizes a computer system called MY SENIOR CENTER, which enables us to be informed of how many people make use of the Senior Center. By registering as a member (no fee involved), you receive a scan card that allows you to designate on the monitor the activity you are enjoying on the day you visit. By swiping your card, the Senior Center may gain additional funds/grants based on how many feet walk through the doors. If you do not yet have a scan card, please see an administrative assistant on your next visit. Please note that information you provide is never shared with anyone. 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


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
