



The AARP Foundation is again providing free tax assistance and preparation plus e-filing for taxpayers with low to moderate income through the AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program. AARP Foundation Tax-Aide is the Nation's largest free tax assistance and preparation service, giving special attention to those 60 and older. You do not need to be a member of AARP or a retiree to use this free service.

Taxpayers are encouraged to have the following documents when they arrive at an AARP Tax-Aide site to get their returns completed:

- Photo ID and Social Security Card
- Copy of last year's (2021) tax return
- · Health insurance coverage information for taxpayer, spouse, and all dependents
- · Seniors with full-year enrollment in Medicare need only bring their SSA-1099 with them
- Calendar year 2022 real estate tax bills and dates of payment (needed for Circuit Breaker benefit filing)
- Calendar year 2022 water and sewer charges (needed for Circuit Breaker benefit filing)
- All other income tax related documents

The Tax-Aide program will be available at the Westminster Senior Center starting in January/February.
