
Hope to see you there!!!

- ★ New Medicare cards are currently being mailed through April 2019. Your Social Security number will be removed from your card to protect your identity. You'll get a new Medicare card with a number that's unique to you and this number can only be used for your Medicare coverage. There will be no changes to your benefits. Beware of anyone who contacts you about your new card. Medicare and Social Security will not call you for personal information. Do not give any personal information to anyone you do not know. If your address needs to be corrected, contact Social Security at 800-772-1213 or visit SSA.Gov/MyAccount. If you have questions about your Medicare benefits or about the new Medicare card, please call the Massachusetts Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) Program at 800-892-0890 or Shine Program at 800-AGE-INFO (800-243-4636).
- ★ Massachusetts Senior Legal Helpline (Phone Number 800-342-5297) provides free legal information and referral services to Massachusetts residents who are 60 years old or older. They are available Monday through Friday, 9:00 am 12:00 n.
- **★** If you worry about the well-being of your elderly neighbor, please call the Senior Center. We can make a home visit to ensure that they are safe and aware of the services we have to offer.




