






The Westminster Senior Center Book Club Meets on the 1st Monday Morning of the Month





## **Volunteers Needed for Tax Preparation**

Tax-Aide, a partnership between IRS and AARP Foundations, needs volunteer counselors to help low- and moderate-income persons in your community prepare their Federal and Massachusetts income taxes. Additional positions for site greeters are also available.

Last year, over 4,700 returns were prepared at 41 sites around Worcester County. Nationally, almost 3 million taxpayers avail themselves of Tax-Aide services. Volunteers work 4-6 hours per week for the eleven weeks during tax preparation season—February 1 to April 15. Training for volunteer preparers will start in November, most of the training will be online. Internet access and basic computer skills are necessary.


