

Sit-down style meals are served at 11:30 am, costing \$3.00 (payable at time of meal). Included with your meal is the main entrée, all the fixings, dessert, and cold/hot drinks. To view the entrée of the day, please refer to the Newsletter's "Activities" page, on the respective meal day (Monday, Wednesday, or Friday). To reserve your seat, please call the Senior Center. Can You Laminate Your Medicare Card?

The Social Security Department advises against card lamination in general because the card may have built-in security features that could be compromised by lamination. As an alternative, for a few dollars at your local business supply store, you can purchase a plastic ID card holder to protect your Medicare card.

FOOD SAFETY FOR HOME-DELIVERED MEALS



Hot or cold ready-prepared meals are perishable and can cause illness when mishandled. Leaving food out too long at room temperature can cause bacteria to grow to dangerous levels that can cause illness. Proper handling is essential to ensure the food is safe to eat.

THE DANGER ZONE: Temperatures between 40 °F and 140 °F. Bacteria grow most rapidly in this range - doubling in number in as little as 20 minutes.

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO KEEP YOUR FOOD SAFE:

- 1) Discard perishable foods if left out at room temperature more than two hours.
- 2) Discard food after one hour if the temperature is above 90 °F.
- 3) Refrigerate hot meals if you don't plan to eat them immediately and reheat later.
- 4) Cold meals should be eaten within two hours (one hour if room temp is above 90 °F) or refrigerated or frozen for eating at another time.
- 5) Reheat food to 165 °F using a food thermometer. Bring soup or gravy to a rolling boil. If using a microwave oven to reheat food, cover food and rotate the dish so food heats evenly. This prevents any "cold spots" from harboring bacteria.
- 6) Refrigerate and freeze foods properly using the guidelines below:

REFRIGERATOR STORAGE AT 40 °F OR BELOW

Cooked meat or poultry	3 to 4 days	
Pizza	3 to 4 days	
Luncheon meats	3 to 5 days	
Egg, tuna, & macaroni salads	3 to 5 days	

FREEZER STORAGE AT 0 °F OR BELOW

Cooked meat or poultry	2 to 6 months	
Pizza	1 to 2 months 1 to 2 months


It's that time of year again! If you are enrolled in a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO/PPO), expect an information packet from your plan by the end of September. It is important to understand and save this information: it explains the changes in your plan for 2019. Premiums, deductibles, co-pays, and the drugs covered by your plan can change significantly!

During Medicare Open Enrollment, you can adjust your plan for next year. SHINE Counselors help you understand your plan changes as well as other options you may have. Call now to discuss your insurance questions, schedule your SHINE phone or face-to-face appointment, or learn about group meetings during the Open Enrollment from October 15 through December 7!

REMINDER: Be on the alert for your new Medicare card in the mail and as always, bring your card and drug list to your appointment!

You can call your local Senior Center or call 1-800-AGE -INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say 3. If you get the SHINE answering machine, leave your name and number. A volunteer will call you back as soon as possible.


