- Tom Torrens presented monitoring data/reporting from Northrop Grumman's cadmium contamination adjacent to the Crocker Pond property.
- Need to understand from Town Council if transfer of Parcel B or an easement to Bob Francis is legally possible before the question can be considered further.
- The Committee has questions for Conservation and the Department of Public Works for the evaluation of building a new access road through Parcel B to the parking lot.
- Stephanie Lahtinen requested next steps to evaluate the feasibility to construct a road to the pond parking lot and the history of why the road wasn't built after the town acquired the Crocker Pond property.
- Bob Francis' letter expressing interest in an easement to access his landlocked parcel D to utilize for storage/staging, and the return of Parcel B back to him that was deeded to the town as part of the sale of Crocker Pond for the addition of a road.
- 2022 Annual Report updates discussed.
- Sharon Lewis to spearhead preparation of a historical record/album for the pond.
