46 Midstate Trail

The Midstate Trail is a scenic footpath located in Worcester County, 45 miles west of Boston. This 95 mile hiking trail extends from Rhode Island's North-South Trail; crossing the gentle hills of central Massachusetts and eventually connecting to the Wapack Trail in New Hampshire. The Midstate Trail is highly accessible, easy to hike and the best way to enjoy the natural side of the region. **There are several points of access in Westminster for the Midstate Trail:** the parking lot at the Wachusett Mountain Ski Area; the parking lot for Redemption Rock Historical Site along Route 140 in Princeton; Narrows Road near the Stone Hill Road corner; along Merriam Road near Battles Road; next to the Graffiti Bridge on Oakmont Avenue; and, the "lot" off Bragg Hill Road just north of South Ashburnham Road. For all trailheads, just look for the signs at road crossings and follow the yellow triangles into the woods. Open year-round.

The park consists of approximately 57 acres on the east side of the road, abutting Woodside Cemetery and surrounding the Water Treatment facility. There are another 18 \pm acres located on the west side of Route 140. The Commission oversees the Wachusett Rambler Recreation Area, a nine acre parcel which abuts the main part of Hager Park. The Rambler has recently been cleared and undergone a field restoration, providing views of Wachusett and other locations. The Commission also administers the Smith Reservoir and Raymond properties containing another 82 \pm acres. The Commission has developed a network of trails within the Hager Park and Rambler parcels. The trails are open to the public. A map of the trails can be downloaded from the Hager Park page on the Town's website.

48 Muddy Pond Conservation Area

This Town-owned conservation area consists of 500 acres of protected land and contains the 30-acre Muddy Pond, one of the most peaceful places in the region. The Midstate Trail bisects the property and is accessed from two spur trails off Bragg Hill Road and a Midstate Trail pull-in on Bragg Hill Road just north of South Ashburnham Road (look for the yellow triangles to access the Midstate). Excellent wildlife viewing area and there's even an Adirondack (three-sided) shelter overlooking the pond.

This State-owned conservation property lies within the southern tip of Westminster off Route 140 and in the neighboring town of Princeton. It contains 2,250 acres (706 acres in Westminster), many of which are well developed for hiking and nature appreciation. Additional amenities on the site include a summit lookout with automobile and chairlift access, numerous picnic areas, an information center and sanitary and parking facilities. The Midstate Trail runs through the middle of the park and crosses the summit, entering at the ski area at the north end and from Audubon land from the south.
