To the INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF WESTMINSTER
in the WORCESTER AND
MIDDLESEX Senatorial
District.

Whereas, by the twenty-fourth article of the Amendments of the Constitution, it is provided that any vacancy in the Senate shall be filled by election by the people of the unrepresented district, upon the order of a majority of the Senators elected: and Whereas, by reason of THE RESIGNATION OF JENNIFER L. FLANAGAN heretofore sitting as Senator from the WORCESTER AND MIDDLESEX Senatorial District, a vacancy exists in the Senate, and said District is unrepresented therein: and Whereas, a majority of Senators elected have, by their order, directed the President of the Senate to issue a precept appointing a time for an election to fill said vacancy.

Now, therefore, I STANLEY C. ROSENBERG President of the Senate, by virtue and in pursuance of the aforesaid order, do hereby direct and require you, in the manner and forms prescribed by Our Constitution and Laws, to notify and summon the inhabitants of the said WORCESTER AND MIDDLESEX Senatorial District qualified to vote for Senators to give in their votes on TUESDAY, the FIFTH day of DECEMBER, two thousand and SEVENTEEN, for a Senator to fill said vacancy; and in all matters pertaining to said election and the returns thereof to take similar proceedings as in an original election.

Witness my hand and the Seal of the Senate hereunto affixed at Boston, this 28th day of August, in the year two thousand and SEVENTEEN, and the two hundred and FORTY-FIRST of the Independence of the United States of America.
