Community Preservation Act (CPA)?

The CPA is a state law that allows Massachusetts communities who adopt the CPA to add a small surcharge on property taxes for a **local** Community Preservation Fund which will be matched by the state. This fund is used to build and rehabilitate parks, playgrounds, and recreational fields, protect open space, support local affordable housing development, and preserve historic buildings and resources.
