- R.E. Betty Joe Way Proposed Submission Comments
 - 1) Fire Department Access Roadway
 - a) 80,000-pound load shall be calculated for an approved weight rating.
 - b) The curb cut radius to roadway A shall be able to accept our turning requirements as attached.
 - c) Roadway 20' wide access road with a minimum of 15' surfaced and loaded for item a.
 - d) Provide means for fire apparatus to turn around at the end.

18.1.1.4 The fire apparatus access plans shall bear the seal and signature of the responsible registered professional engineer.

18.2.2.1.1.1 Approval of access roads shall be subject to the AHJ and capable of supporting the imposed loads of fire Apparatus and shall be provided with an all-weather driving surface and shall be maintained as provided.

18.2.3.4.1.1 Fire department access roads shall have an unobstructed width of not less than 20 ft (6.1 m). Fire department access roads constructed in the boulevard-style shall be allowed where each lane is less than 20 feet but not less than ten feet when they do not provide access to a building or structure.

- 2) Street Signs A street sign approved by the DPW shall be required to mark the roadway.
- 3) Roadway Name- Submit a roadway name per town requirements for approval.

- 4) **Signatures** Any signature required for the construction of a new dwelling through the reduced road standard sub-division process shall be signed by the Fire Chief. It is the owner's responsibility to notify purchasers in the event of sale of the property of these requirements.
- 5) House Numbers House numbers shall be visible from the created roadway.
