- Call to order
 - O VON SALMI CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:08PM. PRESENT WERE-CHIEF LEBLANC, VON SALMI, KERRY KOSKINEN, CHIEF BUTTERFIELD, DAVID MONTY, DAVID TURCOTTE, PAUL BLANCHARD, LISA ROCHELEAU, CHRIS MOSSMAN, KEITH HARDING, JIM DELISLE; ABSENT: MARK HAWKE, JIM DELISLE, CHRIS MOSSMAN,

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- Meeting minutes of March 24, 2021
 - Motion to accept the meeting minutes of March 24, 2021 as submitted offered by L Rocheleau, Motion seconded by V. Salmi; hearing no further discussion the motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.
- Tecton Programming Update
 - Tecton presented a revised plan for the renovation of the existing public safety building to accommodate the Fire Department
 - o 3 zones of construction Heavy Reno, Minor work, and Refresh
 - o 10% of the building would require heavy renovations
 - Overall, the modifications would be target at \$2.5M dollars for construction
 - o Soft costs would likely be another \$750,000
 - o Total project budget would target not to exceed \$3.5M
 - o Little to no site or building envelope improvement.
 - Chief Butterfield urged that this would be a band-aide approach to make the building last 10 years or less.
 - All in in a single project would maximize efficiency of the design and construction process
 - o Both Schools and DPW have expressed interest in the existing facility
 - o Town Administrator has advised the full project could be funded
 - o Tecton presented a more "squared off" floor plan of 11, 118sf for PD
 - o Site plan showing future Fire addition was presented
 - Need to update the plan and accommodate the Hager Park Trail heads and parking
 - o Request o provide 6-8 parking spaces

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- Survey and Geotech Services Update
 - Colliers that the proposal received from Places Consultants had been authorized by the Town Administrator.
 - Colliers advised the physical survey work should take place on site over the next 10 days.
- Committee working session for development of town Q&A and presentation brochures
