July 11, 2022

6:00 PM Opened Meeting at Public Works Department Office. Reviewed and signed bills for payment.

6:01 PM Commissioner Butterfield made a motion that the Commission sign the Sewer Accounts commitment for the month of June 2022 in the amount of \$529.23 and the Water Accounts commitment for the month of June 2022 in the amount of \$693.40. The motion seconded by Commissioner Barber. Voted unanimously.

## Chapter 90 Project Request- Old Town Farm Road Culvert Replacement

The Director apprised the Commission that bids were opened on June 30, 2022 with 4 bidders. The apparent low bidder was J. Bates & Son LLC at \$519,000.00. The bid is 14% higher than the consultant estimate of \$500.000.00 and recommends offsetting the town appropriation with MassDOT Chapter 90 monies.

6:04 PM Commissioner Butterfield made a motion that the Commission sign the MassDOT Chapter 90 project request for Old Town Farm Road culvert replacement project in the amount of \$37,000.00. The motion seconded by Commissioner Barber. Voted unanimously.

#### Current Drought Status/Water Restriction

The Director apprised the Commission that the Drought Management Task Force has recommended that Central Region increase from Level 1-Mild Drought to Level 2-Significant Drought. Chairman Emerson would like use the message board on Main Street updating the community of the drought situation.

#### Road Paving & Resurfacing- Update

The Assistant Director apprised the Commission that street line painting was completed on Mile Hill Road and Bolton Road as well as FY23 work on South Ashburnham Road, Lovell Street and Church Street.
