6:02 PM May 27, 2023 31st Wachusett Mountain Race road closure request
The Director apprised the Commission of the lane closure request on Mile Hill Road for
the Wachusett Mountain Race held on Saturday May 27, 2023. Commissioner Butterfield
made a motion to approve the request. The motion seconded by Commissioner Barber.
Voted unanimously.

The Director apprised the Commission that the Advisory Board has asked to meet on March 27, 2023 to discuss the FY2024 budget.

Chairman Emerson read a letter from Governor Maura Healey that states Westminster Chapter 90 apportionment for Fiscal Year 2024 is \$421,938.06 and is contingent upon legislative approval.

Chairman Emerson opened the public hearing. Robert Williams from National Grid explained that the request is for one (1) jointly owned pole on North Common Road beginning at a point approximately 1380 feet south of the centerline of the intersection of Oakmont Avenue and North Common Road. Installing P53-50 as a junction pole for a new pole line to service two new residential homes. The Director has no issues with the placement. Chairman Emerson closed the public hearing at 6:12 PM. Commissioner Barber made a motion to grant the pole petition request. The motion seconded by Commissioner Butterfield. Voted unanimously.
