6:00 PM Opened Meeting at Public Works Department Office. Reviewed correspondence and signed bills for payment.

6:01 PM Commissioner Butterfield made a motion that the Commission sign the Water Usage Account Quarterly Billing Commitment for July 2021 in the amount of \$246,491.65 and the Sewer Usage Account Quarterly Billing Commitment for July 2021 in the amount of \$291,607.39. The motion seconded by Chairman Emerson. Voted unanimously.

#### Policy on Water & Sewer Adjustments

The Commission discussed revising the policy. Commissioner Butterfield would like to see the policy be cost neutral. This will be discussed further at next meeting.

# <u>Current Drought Status/Water Use Restriction</u> No new update.

<u>Whitmanville Road Bridge Project Update</u> – The Director informed the Commission that the contractor would be moving to the other side of the bridge and finish date would be later than expected.

<u>Wachusett Brewery Industrial Pretreatment Program discharge permit</u> – The Director discussed with the Commission the brewery's compliance with the permit issued from the City of Fitchburg.

#### 6:05 PM Pole Petition- Old Town Farm Road

Chairman Emerson opened the public hearing. Mattheus Viena from National Grid presented the project. Mr. Viena stated that the petition is for a guy pole to replace a guy wire in a tree. He stated that the property owner fronting the tree with guy wire had concerns with the condition of the tree. The Director had no objection to the location as staked in the field. He stated that National Grid removal the tree once new pole is in place. Commissioner Butterfield made a motion to close the public hearing. The motion seconded by Chairman Emerson. Voted unanimously. Chairman Emerson closed the
