Town Planner requested Advisory Board support of zoning bylaw changes and provided drafts of the zoning changes were provided. Town Planner asks for input / collaboration. Highlights of what was discussed:

- Comments allowed for next 100 days (through mid-March). Many forums available.
- Inclusionary housing bylaw generally doesn't produce affordable housing so looking
- Redesigning the definition of what is a buildable lot.
- Reducing setback standards for sheds.
- Changing conversion language.
- Require a 20-foot non-disturbed vegetative buffer for non-residential when abutting a
- Allowing townhouse apartments.
- New home occupation bylaw; this adds performance standards.
- Accessory dwelling / in-law apartments will allow for rental or aid in helping older
