- 12. The owner will be responsible for maintaining any filtration installed and will be responsible for the safe disposal of spent filter media.
- 13. The owner will be solely responsible for costs related to the implementation of the final solution to the contamination site issue as it pertains to their property.
- 14. The owner recognizes that they will responsible for all ongoing costs incurred meeting these requirements which will be significant and ongoing.
- 15. The liability incurred in drilling this well will pass with the title to the property to subsequent owners.
