Chapter 243 Portable Bathrooms

- A. Permitting
 - a. Companies that are placing Portable Bathrooms in the Town of Westminster must have a current Septage Haulers Permit on file with the Board of Health. Permits must be renewed annually.
 - b. A Portable Bathroom Permit is required for each unit located within Westminster.
 - c. The fee is \$10 per unit, per month. The permit must be renewed every three months if need be.
 - d. This permit must include the following information:
 - i. Septage Haulers Permit number
 - ii. Date(s) of delivery and expected pick up.
 - iii. Maintenance/cleaning/replacement schedule for each unit.
 - e. The Portable Bathroom Permit must be posted at the site where the units are located.
- B. Unit Requirements
 - a. Septage Haulers are responsible for all maintenance/cleaning/replacement of the unites in town.
 - b. All units must be equipped with appropriate facilities for hand hygiene and hand sanitizer.
 - c. All units must be locked at the end of the day or when no one is on site.
 - d. Units are to be located as to not create a nuisance
- C. Inspections
 - a. Inspections of the units by the Board of Health and Health Agent as deemed necessary.
- D. Reporting
 - a. All Septage Haulers shall submit to the Board of Health a Quartely Report on a form provided by the Board of Health.
 - b. The Quarterly Report must include the number and location of all units in place at any time during the quarter. If no units were in place during the quarter, a report is still required, indicating such.
